



## Oral Health Florida Data Action Team

**Minutes: May 18, 2015 Call**

**4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. EST**

Members Attended: Lilli Copp (LC), Denice Curtis (DC), Jill Herndon (JH), Tami Miller (TM), Scott Tomar (ST), Christina Vracar (CV),

1. Welcome/Introductions
  - JH called meeting to order at 4:02 p.m.
  - JH announced that Dr. Bhoopathi who had co-chaired the DAT accepted a position out of state and expressed appreciation for his leadership and significant contributions during the past year.
2. Approval of minutes from February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2015 Teleconference Call
  - Minutes approved.
3. Update from April 24<sup>th</sup> Oral Health Florida Leadership Council Meeting
  - TM provided update from the LC meeting in Claremont:
    - Roadmap update was affirmed.
    - LC discussed FDA withdrawal of its official membership with OHF.
    - Partner updates from AHCA, DOH, and HeadStart were provided.
    - Christy Hom with FIHI updated the LC on the development of the Florida OH Alliance with discussion about how the alliance and OHF will work together going forward. FIHI will stay on LC and invited OHF to participate with the alliance. The first alliance meeting is Friday May 22<sup>nd</sup>, and OHF will send representative (TM).
    - The results based accountability scorecard was demonstrated. The scorecard will align with the roadmap and will be online and interactive.
    - The LC reviewed OHF sustainability and budget, noting that the HRSA workforce grant will provide funding for next three years.
    - Conference planning – draft agenda prepared.
    - Dr. Tomar resigned as Vice Chair but remains on LC; Mr. Ben Browning was nominated for Vice Chair (and was subsequently elected by email ballot).

#### 5. Next Steps for DAT

- Prepare report with updated/current data for OHF Conference
  - TM: Legislative session in 2016 is January, earlier than usual. Consider what updates will be needed.
- Are there other metrics we should explore?

#### **Safety Net Clinic Data**

- DC: In Kansas, safety net clinic data were analyzed and several reporting metrics were developed – could something similar be done for Florida?
- ST: For safety net sites, it may be challenging to get non-Medicaid data.
  - JH: We can check to see if Ben Browning is available to participate in a future call and discuss the data that might be available for reporting.

#### **Medicaid Data**

- TM: AHCA is doing a lot of analyses; could invite AHCA representative to participate in next DAT call to find out what type of analyses are being done.
- TM: Dental Quality Alliance has developed quality measures – possible to align with those?
  - JH: Can check with AHCA to see how they may be using these measures versus other measures such as the HEDIS Annual Dental Visit and CMS-416 data reporting.
- Group: It would be useful to break out the CMS-416 data by age group to see age-specific trends over time. JH volunteered to prepare these reports.

#### **Adult Data**

- What types of data associated with ACA reforms might be available for adults?
- TM: AHCA has prepared reports on dental benefits being provided in marketplace plans. Could check with AHCA on what reporting is being planned and what data may be available.

- CV gave an update on the DOH Burden of Oral Disease document. They have obtained most of the data and will start writing the report narrative in June.
