Thank you for allowing your child to take part in the School Dental Sealant Program.

Your child has received dental sealants on the following teeth that are checked.

- \_\_\_\_\_ upper right first permanent (adult) molar
- \_\_\_\_\_ upper left first permanent (adult) molar
- \_\_\_\_\_ lower left first permanent (adult) molar
- \_\_\_\_\_ lower right first permanent (adult) molar

Dental sealants are thin plastic coatings on the permanent (adult) molars that help prevent tooth decay. The teeth that we sealed may feel a little bigger for a few days. This feeling will go away after a few days.

We have **circled** the letter A, B or C to show you the results of your child's dental screening.

- A. Your child has dental problem(s) that need **immediate attention**. You should immediately make a dental appointment for your child.
  
- B. Your child has evidence of dental problems. In order to avoid serious problems, your child should have treatment within the next two months.
  
- C. Your child was found to have no immediate problems at this time. He or she should have a routine dental checkup every six months by a dentist.
