<b>II.</b>	<b><u>Old Business (S-BSP Data Collection Results):</u></b> <p>Christina Vracar</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) Not all of the responses have been sent in yet</li><li>b) Please make sure to check the number of children screened vs. the number of sealants preformed</li></ul>
<b>III.</b>	<b><u>New Business (Children’s Volunteer Health Network – Walton County):</u></b> <p>Denise Johnson</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) Children’s Volunteer Health Network</li><li>b) Mobile dental clinic that preforms cleanings, exams, x-rays, sealants, and fluoride treatments</li><li>c) Served approximately 4,578 children and performed over 9,000 sealants since the program has been in operation (Year: 2008)</li><li>d) Screen children from K-5</li><li>e) To participate children must qualify for free or reduced lunch</li><li>f) The program has one volunteer dentist to perform screenings and review medical histories on the mobile unit and one FTE dentist at their fixed clinic in south Walton county</li><li>g) Use Dentrax and are completely digital (including x-rays)</li><li>h) Discussion for incentives and program improvements:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Pizza party</li><li>2) Incentive for teachers-extra break</li><li>3) Attend open houses at the schools</li><li>4) Lose the yes/no question on the forms and just have the signature be the “yes” response</li></ul></li></ul>

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<b>IV.</b>	<b><u>New Business (Isolite and SEALS Discussion):</u></b> Elizabeth Orr <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) Isolite is great for half mouth isolation. Sealants are technique sensitive and isolite is helpful for retention rates. Suggested trying it out on each other before purchasing and implementing in you S-BSP.</li><li>b) Still promoting the use of SEALS for S-BSP data collection. As with all new software, there are some slight hiccups in implementation but overall will continue to move forward with this. Q4: What agency in your county currently operates a S-BSP?</li></ul>
