History

- FL Department of Health (FDOH), Public Health Dental Program organized the State Oral Health Improvement Plan Group (2004)
 - Assembled a diverse group of stakeholders (2004 current)
 - Developed first State Oral Health Improvement Plan (2004-2005)
 - Workgroups established and began implementation (2006-2010)
- Name changed to Oral Health Florida (2008)
 - Backbone organization changed from FDOH to Florida Public Health Institute(FPHI) (2011)
 - Updated State Oral Health Improvement Plan (2011-2012)
 - Developed Florida's Roadmap for Oral Health (2012-2014)
 - FPHI withdrew as backbone organization (2014)
 - Florida Public Health Association became fiscal agent (2014)
 - Action Teams implementing Roadmap (2014-current)
 - Oral Health Florida Conferences (2009, 2011, 2012, 2014, 2015)
