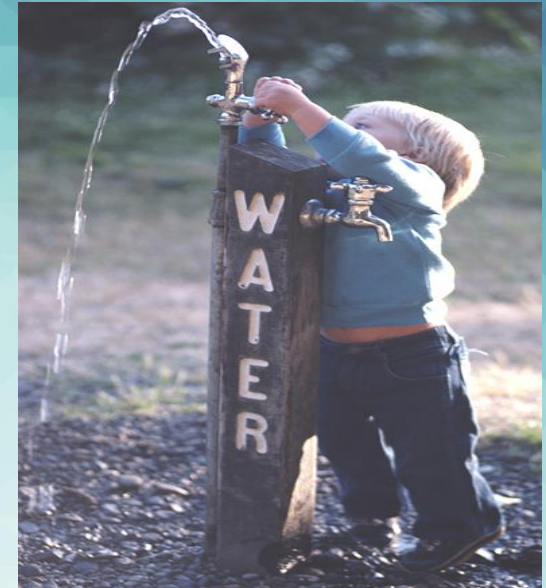

Status of Fluoridation Access

- Currently 77.3% of Floridians on community water systems receive optimally fluoridated water



Status of Fluoridation Access

- Fluoridation is the most cost-effective means of preventing dental decay with positive effects ranging throughout all ages.



Status of Fluoridation Access

- State funds and technical assistance are available through the Public Health Dental Program to help Florida communities with initial efforts to authorize fluoridation and start-up costs.



Status of Fluoridation Access

Since 1949, when Gainesville became the first to initiate community water fluoridation, the State of Florida trend has increased steadily to include more and more families gaining access and benefitting from the protective properties of optimally fluoridated water.
