

## Board of Directors Meeting November 5, 2018 MINUTES

In attendance: Oscar Arevalo, Nancy Zinser, Ana Karina Mascarenas, Greg Smith, Jose Peralta, Deborah Foote

- The Agenda was unanimously adopted (Zinser/Smith)
- The August and September 2018 Minutes were unanimously adopted (Zinser/Arevalo)
- Deborah discussed the OHF financial situation including anticipated expenses and revenues.
  Cash is available to continue through 2018. The September 2018 Financials were unanimously adopted. (Zinser/Mascarenas)

## • Unfinished Business

- Final conference accounting: FPHA will be issuing OHF a check for \$650 bringing total profit to \$1429.24 which will be transferred to the OHF General Fund in November.
- The Fluoridation Contract is in final stages. Includes \$12,500 in an upfront payment and equal monthly payments for the period of the contract all totaled for \$50,000.
- The DentaQuest Foundation grant funding is with their finance department. Anticipate first payment of \$40,000 within the month and the second installment of \$40,000 upon completion of interim report.
- The HRSA Oral Health Workforce Grant contract is in development process and anticipate execution first quarter of 2019. It also will include a small project funded from CDC grant.
- The Policy Committee legislative priorities and meeting were reviewed. Anticipate changes post-election. Nancy will send updates on dental therapy local sessions to all.
- African American Faith Training meeting with potential community partners is later this month. Dr. Manning has been kept up to date on the delays due to partner election involvement.
- Safety Net Committee Update: Deborah is meeting with AHCA to review the framework later this month. FDA and FACHC have indicated interest in participating. Recruitment will happen after AHCA input.

## New Business

- DentaQuest Foundation future direction- Deborah and Dr. Peralta shared the changing landscape of the oral health network (OPEN) and of changes to future grantmaking that will focus on medical/dental integration and expansion of adult dental coverage (Medicaid/Medicare). OHF will need to think strategically about its future.
- Managing Director contract & review of employee/contractor comparison was discussed and will be revisited at next meeting for implementation in 2019.
- Managing Director written report was submitted.
- The Board unanimously approved to extend current payment arrangement with Managing Director through 2018. (Zinser/Mascarenas)
- The next meeting is tentatively set for December 17<sup>th</sup> in the Miami area. It will include a short business meeting and strategic planning retreat that will focus on the direction of organization given the changing funding landscape.
